★ Bryan Dunlop, International Speaker

A former Gurkha soldier, Bryan was taken captive whilst working on a diamond mine in Angola. Evacuated after 4 days he immediately elected to return to the war-torn country and his entire team followed him back. Now a highly respected international speaker and business consultant, Bryan works with individuals, teams and FTSE 100 companies to help them deliver better results, regardless of their challenges. Bryan will host this year's conference and share his own thoughts on *Making Things Happen*.



★ Dr John Bird MBE, Global Entrepreneur

John Bird is not your typical business leader. He was born into the underclass, made homeless at the age of seven, in prison by the time he was a teenager and slept rough on the streets of London. From this inauspicious start he went on to buy and sell products and services and build global businesses. He has earned international respect as a dynamic leader and as such has delivered talks to world leaders in Ten Downing Street, Buckingham Palace and The United Nations in New York, amongst many others. John will draw on a lifetime of experiences to share his thoughts on *Leadership*.



★ Annie Rooney, Local Start-up Global Brand

Annie Rooney is the co-founder of Suki Tea. The company formed in 2005 and initially operated from a stall in St George's Market in a quest for the perfect cuppa. The dream was to open Belfast's first teahouse but soon they were selling so much tea wholesale around Belfast and beyond that the focus of the business changed. The company now employs 10 people and is developing its global position with new distribution deals in 11 international markets as diverse as Japan, Kenya and Spain. Winner of the 2011 UTV Business Eye SME of the Year, Annie will reflect on her own managerial journey and will tell *The Suki Tea Story*.



★ Stuart Harvey, Serial Entrepreneur

A native of Belfast, Stuart spent his early career with Reuters in London, New York and Berlin. He co-founded Harco Technology in 1997 and led the company's growth in London and Belfast. Within 10 years the company had 40 major Investment Banks as clients, with installations in over 80 trading floors worldwide. Harco merged with Wombat Financial Software in 2007 and the combined venture was sold to the New York Stock Exchange in early 2008, in what was Ireland's largest financial services acquisition. Stuart was an early stage investor in the venture capital funded i-Path Diagnostics, and was the company's first CEO. During his talk Stuart will offer *Management Lessons from a Serial Entrepreneur*.



★ Bill McCallion BSc MD FRCSpaed, Paediatric Surgeon

Bill manages and leads where the stakes are high and the outcome, on many occasions, is the difference between life and death. Having qualified as a doctor, he then trained in the UK and South Africa and is now a Consultant Paediatric Surgeon at the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children. Reflecting on his 20 year career Bill will share his experiences and views on personality and leadership styles. He will deliver a talk entitled *Managing in Critical Situations*, sharing lessons that can be applied to any management context.
