René Carayol MBE - World-Leading Executive and Leadership Coach

René has worked closely with history-defining leaders such as Mikael Gorbachev, Nelson Mandela, Sir Richard Branson, Bill Clinton and Kofi Annan. He is also a best-selling business author and in his latest book, SPIKE, he asserts that none of these world-renowned leaders are flawless or 'allrounders'. However, they all tend to know their 2-3 Spikes, and have taken the time and focus to fine tune them to near Olympic standard. Crucially, René himself has actually been Chairman, CEO and MD of blue chip businesses, including serving on the boards of M&S, IPC Media & Pepsi. René's messages take the form of practical, real life experiences, delivered with electrifying effect.

Niall McGrath and Tom Gannon: Co-Founders of Fulfil Nutrition

Friends Niall and Tom were working together in a marketing firm when they identified an opportunity to create health bars that actually tasted good. Following significant research, a 'home chocolate-making kit' and both of their houses put up as collateral, they launched their first Fulfil Vitamin and Protein Bar in 2016. In their first year they sold 15 million bars − equating to roughly €30 million in sales at retail tills. Those figures have doubled in 2017 and are set for a significant increase again in 2018. Fulfil products are now sold throughout Europe, the Middle East, Australasia and, later in 2018, the USA. The company has also established a presence on high streets with its own range of cafés.

Mark Gallagher - Formula One Leader and Business Autho

Having worked at the forefront of the Formula One motor racing industry for 30 years, holding executive roles at Jordan Grand Prix, Red Bull Racing and Cosworth, Mark has worked with many of the sport's leading Drivers, Owners and CEOs. In the process, he has developed a unique insight into the way they operate. Mark's latest book, 'The Business of Winning – Strategic Success from the Formula One track to the Boardroom', has received acclaim from the worlds of business and motor sport and he is currently collaborating with 13-time Formula One race winner David Coulthard on a business book to be published in the early summer.

Cathriona Hallahan - Managing Director, Microsoft Irelan

Cathriona joined Microsoft as an Accounts Clerk in 1986 – she is now Managing Director for Microsoft in Ireland, responsible for driving commercial and consumer business on the island of Ireland. She has managed large teams with regional and global responsibilities across a range of functions, as well as directing Supply Chain Management, Logistics, Customer Care and IT & Financial support for Europe, Middle East and Africa.

Professor Phil Scraton - Criminologist, Social Researcher and Author

Phil is best-known for leading the Hillsborough Independent Panel's research team and was lead author of its ground-breaking 2013 Report, 'Hillsborough'. He was Adviser to the families' legal teams throughout the inquests and his new edition of 'Hillsborough: The Truth' was published in 2016. In the same year he was awarded Freedom of the City of Liverpool and honorary DLaws by its university, his alma mater. He is Professor Emeritus in the School of Law, Queen's University Belfast, and was a factual consultant on, and contributor to, the 2017 BAFTA winning documentary 'Hillsborough'. In the same year he was Castaway on the BBC's Desert Island Discs radio programme.
